



Newsletter for those living close to the building of Framtidens SÖS

Stockholm County Council is currently undertaking its largest ever investment in health care. The health care of the whole of the county is under development and the investment in Södersjukhuset (Stockholm South General Hospital) is an important piece of the puzzle. At Södersjukhuset we are extending the hospital on the western side using the name Framtidens SÖS.

The new hospital will be ready around the end of 2018/early 2019. There will then be a new treatment building here, a new medical building, new A&E department for adults and a new supply building. The external environment will be greener than previously and will feel more like a neighborhood. The new buildings will be of the same style and color as the old hospital, but with a modern expression.

Demolition and blasting in the building area

Many buildings have already been demolished. Earth and excavation work continues across the whole of the work area. Water cannon will be used to minimize the spread of dust.

The remaining hospital wing on the southern side will also be demolished.

Adapted working hours for blasting

We use a method called careful blasting, which means that we measure the vibrations and that mats are placed over the holes for each blasting. The mats lessen the sound and protect against splinters.

The building of Framtidens SÖS is being carried out whilst the Södersjukhuset is in full operation. This places particular demands on the project to fit in to sensitive and essential activities such as radiotherapy and x-rays and operations. Following agreement with the hospital's chief medical officer, the hospital also works around our blasting times. The agreement means that we can carry out blasting in a time frame of 5 minutes at (07:00), 09:00, 12:00, 15:00, 18:00 (and 20:00).

Before starting blasting, the bore holes must be charged and the blasting mats must be put in place. For security reasons, this cannot be done until just before blasting. When we have carried out the last blasting for the day, the mats must be removed from the site for security reasons.

Warning! Immediately prior to each blasting there will be a short sound signal and when the blasting is at an end there will be a long sound signal.

The Swedish Environmental Protection Agency's guidelines on noise from building sites specify different values at differing times of the day and night. We can perform blasting during the time specified as "daytime", i.e. 07:00 – 19:00.



Take the walkway and get a sneak preview of one of the new façades!

The construction traffic is intensive in the area, with approximately 150 transportations every day. We therefore ask everyone to be extra careful when walking in the area. Use the walkway around the buildings by Jägargatan 20. You now have the opportunity to view a full scale sample of one of the new façades. Experience the color, structure and size.

We are working actively to create a safe and reliable traffic environment around the building. All the contractors and the hospital's transporters have been advised to be prudent and take pedestrians into consideration. We put heavy shielding in place when necessary. Speed indicator signs have been placed in Jägargatan showing drivers their speeds.
