



Code of conduct when sharing an apartment

Tenants sharing an apartment must be considerate and respect each other and the facilities. For most people it is a question of common sense. It can however be helpful with common rules to refer to:

- Good manners is important when sharing an apartment with another tenant. Be nice and keep a good attitude to your flat mate. Both verbal and in text.
- Remember that everyone is different and has other habits. When sharing an apartment with another tenant, you may need to be prepared to adapt your habits and compromise.
- All accommodation areas should be quiet between 22-07 on weekdays and between 22-08 on weekends. There are to be no parties that can disturb your flat mate or neighbors during this time.
- Never take your flat mate's food without asking.
- Empty the garbage bins regularly.

- Keep the kitchen and bathroom clean. For example, remove any hair in the shower drain or wash basin.

- At last but not least, always think of leaving the shared facilities as you want to find them yourself!

It is important that you communicate with each other. Remember to inform/ask your flat mate first if you:

- Want to have guests staying over-night.
- Want to invite friends. When you arrive home after a long day, the last thing you might want is to encounter people you do not know and had not expected in your home.
